### Concerned about an adult? Reporting abuse in County Durham

If the person is in immediate danger call 999 straight away.

To report abuse or neglect you can:

- call [Social Care Direct](#) 24 hours a day on 03000 26 79 79
- contact the police on 101 if you have concerns that someone is a victim of modern slavery or human trafficking, or at risk of radicalisation
- immediately report your concerns to a member of staff if you are a patient or visitor to a hospital or other health facility

### Domestic abuse

Harbour Support Services supports people in County Durham affected by domestic abuse, with refuges, and through telephone and video support sessions.

- Call Harbour 24 hours a day on 03000 20 25 25
